Parking charge structure for County Garage #58



CashKey enables you to purchase and spend value of any kind electronic "Key" that can be used in all electronic purchasing areas provided by Montgomery County.

CashKey Has "Key Advantages" over Coins

Carry CashKey in your key ring - there's no need to go into a purse or wallet when you leave your car!

CashKey can be used in combination with coins, and later added to the cash keypad to be



inserted into the keypad. CashKey is available in 25-cent increments at all vending machines.

Here's How CashKey Works!



Insert the CashKey into the hole that fits next to the meter's coin slot. The meter will take the value of the key.



Remove the CashKey and your time purchased is added to the meter. If there's any time left on your CashKey, you can use it again. You can also cancel the time on CashKey.



When your CashKey value runs low or reaches zero, you can "re-charge it" at any CashKey value location. CashKey's 25-cent keys only cost 20 cents. Visit www.montgomerycountymd.gov for more information.







SSMC IV Timeline General



- Provide access from SSMC III garage to G2 Level of SSMC IV (Completed)
- Install new gates on G2 and Bennington entrance (completed)
- Power wash garage – SSMC IV (1/27 – 1/28)
- Begin barrier construction (COB 2/03)
- Re-stripe and install new way finding signage (2/04 – 2/05)
- Normal garage operation (2/06)
- Remaining construction to last 2 to 4 weeks



SSMC IV Timeline

Assigned Parking



- Provide general description to parkers on the changes to the garage parking areas
- Maintain list of parkers who express interest in assigned parking
- Inform assigned parkers of parking space number (1/30 – 2/03)
- Execute new parking agreement and distribute new hangtag (1/30 – 2/03)
- Re-assign access control cards to open G-1 and G-2 gates according to space number and level (2/03)



SSMC IV Timeline

Open Parking



- All current parkers who do not desire assigned parking or who did not respond to the SSMC Mgmt. office will be in the open parking areas
- All open parkers will be receiving a new transmitter tag (transferable) to gain access to gates at the Bennington entrance (1/30 – 2/03)
- Execute new parking agreement and distribute new hangtag (1/30 – 2/03)


